



2020 Summer Tennis Camp

Things To Know

Revised 6/30/2020

Camp is for children 5 to 14 years of age. Camp will be held on the indoor tennis courts. Campers 5 to 6 years old may be in the group fitness room if it is necessary to provide more court space.

Early Drop-Off is available at 9:00 am. Please let Penn Oaks know you are dropping off your camper early so staff is prepared.

Aftercare is available from 4:30 to 5:30 pm. Cost is \$25/day. Please let Penn Oaks know your camper is staying until 5:30 pm so staff is prepared.

Precautions and processes in place due to Covid-19:

Camp registrations will be limited to 6 to 1 camper to instructor ratio.

Campers must bring their own racquets, water bottle, snack if desired and lunch if registered for full day. Demo racquets will not be available for use.

Mask for campers are optional. Masks are required for anyone else entering the building.

Campers will be instructed not to touch the balls. The instructors will handle the pickup.

Campers will enter the facility at the main entrance and go directly to the indoor tennis courts. Staff will direct the campers when they arrive to facilitate social distancing. It is not required for parents to check in their camper each day.

At the end of each session, campers will exit through the side door at court 3. Staff will help direct the campers safely back to the front entrance for pick up.

Each court will have designated areas for campers to put their equipment, snack and take water breaks. Campers will remain on their assigned court throughout the session. Staff will take lunch and put in refrigerator if required.

Campers staying for lunch will eat in small groups socially distanced from one another. Staff will retrieve lunch from refrigerator at lunch time.

Facility Update

In late May Penn Oaks had a company perform a disinfecting fogging and our cleaning company did a thorough cleaning of the facility which included the front desk area, locker rooms, main hallways, gym, upstairs and hallway to the indoor tennis courts. Throughout the day staff will disinfect the front desk area, locker rooms, hallways and other surfaces frequently touched. A plexi-glass barrier has been placed at the front desk and our desk staff will be wearing masks.
